Important Health Warning About Playing Video Games

Photosensitive seizures

A very small percentage of people may experience a seizure when exposed to certain visual images, including flashing lights or patterns that may appear in video games. Even people who have no history of seizures or epilepsy may have an undiagnosed condition that can cause these "photosensitive epileptic seizures" while watching video games.

These seizures may have a variety of symptoms, including lightheadedness, altered vision, eye or face twitching, jerking or shaking of arms or legs, disorientation, confusion, or momentary loss of awareness. Seizures may also cause loss of consciousness or convulsions that can lead to injury from falling down or striking nearby objects.

Immediately stop playing and consult a doctor if you experience any of these symptoms. Parents should watch for or ask their children about the above symptoms—children and teenagers are more likely than adults to experience these seizures. The risk of photosensitive epileptic seizures may be reduced by taking the following precautions: Sit farther from the screen; use a smaller screen; play in a well-lit room; do not play when you are drowsy or fatiqued.

If you or any of your relatives have a history of seizures or epilepsy, consult a doctor before playing.



Years after the events that took place in the original Silent Hill, Heather - once a regular teenager, finds she is being drawn into a nightmare world, of which she has no escape or other option, but to unravel the mysteries of her past... even if it means returning to that sinister town...

NOTE: This manual refers to the default control settings.

Change the control settings in Button Config in the Options menu.

NOTE: Sideways movement can only be done if your control setting is set to 3D Type.

NOTE: This game is compatible with the vibration feature.

Saving your Game

Save your game progress at save points found during your journey. When you investigate a save point, the Save screen is displayed and you can select the desired save file.

SILENT HILL 2 SAVE POINT: The square red object is the save point.

SILENT HILL 3 SAVE POINT: The location with large red circles is the save point.

Starting the Game

Once you have selected the Silent Hill game you wish to play, you can choose the difficulty settings of the combat and puzzles.

Item Menu

Press the button to display the item menu where you can select weapons or items. Select the item or weapon you want to use and press the displayed command.

Status

This is the main character's stamina. As they take damage, it becomes gradually disturbed and changes from blue (healthy) to red (seriously wounded).

Equipped Weapon Command

These are commands that can be used for the selected item or weapon.

Weapon, Item, etc.

Weapons, items, and other objects in your possession are displayed here.

Other Menu Items

OPTION: Opens the Option Screen.

MEMO: View information about puzzle-solving hints you've discovered.

MAP: Opens the Map Screen.

Action

The following basic actions are used throughout both games.

Move

Controls vary depending on your selected control settings.

In all cases, however, you press the X button to run while moving.

3D TYPE: Press the directional buttons right/left or the left stick right/left to change the direction you're facing, and press the directional buttons up/down or the left stick up/down to move forward or back. Press the B button and the B button to change your direction 180° degrees.

2D TYPE: Press the directional buttons or the left stick in the direction you want to move.

Ready Stance and Attack

Press the button to get ready to face an enemy with your selected weapon. While in this stance, press the button to attack. Press the button next to a downed enemy to kick them.

Guard

Press the & button in sync with the enemies attack to guard (you cannot guard while in ready stance). If you are successful, you won't take any damage.

NOTE: Some attacks cannot be guarded against.

Search View

If you press the button, the camera shifts to the main character's perspective.

This mode is called search view and when you are in this mode, you can control the camera with the right stick.

NOTE: There are some locations where search view cannot be used.

Combine Items to Solve Puzzles

Combining multiple items and using them together is sometimes the only way to solve certain puzzles. In cases like this, go to the item menu and use the Combine command. Select the items you want to combine and then choose the USE command.

Pay Attention to the Main Character's Face Direction

As you move, the main character's face moves to look in a certain direction when he or she discovers items, doors, and save points.

Sometimes this is the game's way of giving hints as to how to proceed, so pay close attention.
